## Packing Tips - Dad

Try this packing order for the car when getting ready for your big trip.

- Clothes, games and toys in first.
- Food second
- Kitchen third
- Tents and sleeping gear last

What this means is that when you arrive at your destination you can get the tent and sleeping arrangements setup first. Especially handy if you arrive late to site.

Spend the first day travelling, arriving and getting set up and unpacked. Then deal with the rest. When breaking camp, packing order is less important.
